
### Lewiston Harvest Festival and Fatima Shrine

Then stop for a short visit at the Fatima Shrine with its 15 acres of gardens, highlighted by the glass domed Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima. Lunch on your own at one of the vendors booths, one of the many quaint restaurants in the village, or at the Shrine’s cafeteria.



### Historic Riviera Theatre in North Tonawanda

This tour departs at 9 AM and returns at 1 PM. Step back in time as you are welcomed into this beautiful Italian Renaissance style show place, built in 1926. Marvel at the sound of the Mighty Wurlitzer Organ! Explore “behind the scenes” as you tour the stage, dressing rooms and projection booth, and learn the secrets of the theatre. No visit to the “Riv” would be complete without a featured silent movie accompanied by the Wurlitzer organ. Lunch on your own at one of the several great restaurants near by.



### Culinary Institute of Niagara Falls

Walk around the corner from the hotel to the beautifully renovated (former Rainbow Mall) now a state of the art Culinary School operated by Niagara County Community College. During the 45 minute walking tour you will hear the history of the building, tour various cuisine labs and retail spaces and see the students in action.
